PATHWAY TO LICENSURE

1

- An advisor will be assigned to help navigate your program
- Complete FBI background check before your 1st field experience

COMPLETE 100 & 200 LEVEL CLASSES

- Earn a C- or higher in all required classes
- Earn permission to apply

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APPLY TO THE PROGRAM

- Your advisor will let you know when you are eligible to apply to the program. Eligibility requirements:
 - completed all 100 & 200 level classes with a C- or higher
 - have a cumulative GPA of 2.5

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AFTER ADMISSION TO THE PROGRAM

- Review Handbook
- Complete all remaining classes with a C- or higher
- Attend all required professional development
- Maintain good grades and dispositions
- Login to Student Learning & Licensure (SL&L) account
- Complete required modules

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APPLY TO STUDENT TEACHING EXPERIENCE

- Attend the junior meeting
- Complete placement questionnaire
- Set up an appointment to meet with the Director of Field Experience

PERMISSION TO STUDENT TEACH

- To be eligible to student teach you must:
 - have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher
 - have an education GPA of 2.75 or higher
 - have a major GPA of 2.50 or higher
 - pass all required classes with a C- or higher

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STUDENT TEACHING AND LICENSURE

- Obtain a DCI or FBI
- Prepare and submit the edTPA
- Complete all modules for your program
 - Meet CPAST expectations
- Pass all licensure exams
- Complete all student teaching hours
- Graduate
- Apply for license with Ohio Dept. of Education
